Good Clinical Laboratory Practice. Module 3 now available

Good Clinical Laboratory Practice (GCLP) is a free, online, multi-module training course developed by The Global Health Network and the Global Health Clinical Consortium*.

GCLP: Facilities, Equipment, Materials & Reagents is the third module of the seven module course 'Good Clinical Laboratory Practice'. This module provides a detailed analysis of GCLP guidance for laboratory facilities including biosafety, design, workflow, security, archiving and waste disposal. It also analyses GCLP guidance for equipment, materials and reagents utilised in the laboratory and how they are implemented and managed.

The remaining modules of this course are under development and will be released sequentially once they are finalised and peer reviewed. A certificate of completion will be awarded for each individual module until all modules become available and an overall course certificate can be awarded.

'Ethics in epidemics, emergencies and disasters: Research, surveillance and patient care' now available

- Boundaries between public health practice, surveillance, and research.
- Processes for ethical review.
- Conflicts between the common good and individual autonomy in surveillance, research and clinical trials.
- Publication ethics.
- Triage, resource allocation and standards of care.
- Professional duties of health care workers during public health surveillance and research.
